Blue – Front, Yellow – Middle, Red – Back

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES

At Wainui a player may obtain distance information by using a distance measuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g., gradient, wind speed, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3.

DISTANCE MARKERS

All distances are measured to the centre of the greens. Fairway distance plates are at 100, 125, 150, 200 and 250 meters positioned in the middle of each fairway.

WAINUI LOCAL RULES

The following Local Rules are to be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf and any additional local rules as determined by the Golf Club due to changing conditions.

OUT OF BOUNDS

Beyond any fences, wooden white stakes and/or white paint lines defining the boundary of the course.

WATER HAZARDS

Water Hazards are defined by yellow stakes and/or yellow paint lines. Lateral Water Hazards are defined by red stakes. As an additional option if a ball crosses the lateral hazard line on holes 1, 2, 6, 7, 12 & 16 then the player may under penalty of one stroke use the dropping zone.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

(Rule 24-2) All artificially surfaced roads, pathways, bridges, sprinkler heads, staked shrubs & trees and distance markers except when a ball is in a water hazard. Free relief is available when the obstruction physically interferes with the lie of the ball, your stance or your intended swing. You may lift the ball and drop it within one club length of the nearest point of relief but not nearer the hole. Relief may be taken from obstructions (eg - sprinkler heads) if the obstruction lies within two club lengths of the putting greens and the ball lies within two club lengths of the obstruction and the obstruction is on the line of play.

EMBEDDED BALL Rule 25-2

Through the green, a ball that is embedded in its own pitch-mark in the ground may be marked and lifted without penalty, cleaned and dropped not nearer the hole.

ABNORMAL GROUND CONDITIONS GUR Rule 25

Will be defined by blue lines and or ground under repair signage.

BALL STRIKING GOLF CART SIGNAGE

If a ball in motion strikes any cart directional signage, the ball may be replayed without penalty.

BALL COMING TO REST IN AN AREA IN A BUNKER WHERE THE SAND HAS BEEN SCoured OUT BY RAIN

Relief is available for a ball coming to rest in an area in a bunker where the sand has been scoured out by rain. Any such area is deemed an abnormal ground condition and relief may be taken under Rule 25.1 (b)(ii). The ball may be dropped in the bunker no nearer the hole for no penalty or outside the bunker for a one-shot penalty.

BALL PLAYED PROVISIONALLY FOR A BALL THAT MAY BE IN A SPECIFIC WATER HAZARD- Holes 2, 6, 15, 17 & 18

If there is doubt whether a ball is in or is lost in the water hazard (on the 2nd, 6th, 15th, 17th & 18th holes), the player may play another ball provisionally under any of the applicable options in 26-1. If the original ball is found outside the water hazard, the player must continue play with it. If the original ball is found in the water hazard, the player may either play the original ball as it lies or continue with the ball played provisionally under 26-1. If the original ball is not found or identified within the five-minute search period, the player must continue with the ball played provisionally.

LOCAL RULES

To be read in conjunction with Local Rules Board

COURSE DEFINITION

Out of Bounds

Defined by white stakes and white lines and all boundary and road fences. Includes paved path from the rear of the practice green to the end of the carpark indicated by white markings.

A ball that crosses the road and comes to rest beyond the road is out of bounds, even though it may lie on another part of the course.

Abnormal Course Conditions

Ground Under Repair is defined by an area encircled in white lines.

Relief **MUST** be taken in accordance with Rule 16.1b.

Bark Covered Areas

Bark covered areas and gardens are integral objects of the course.

LOCAL RULES

Fixed Sprinkler Heads and Drainage Grates

are immovable obstructions.

In addition, if the ball lies in a *general area* and such an obstruction is on or within 2 club lengths of the *putting green* and is within 2 club lengths of the ball, line of play relief may be taken in accordance with Rule 16.1b.

(Exception - There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable)

Breach of Local Rule

Unless otherwise noted, the penalty for breach of a Local Rule is the *general penalty* (stroke play - two strokes : match play - loss of hole)

READY GOLF

The Club adopts a ready golf policy to encourage prompt play.

In stroke play, players are allowed and encouraged to play out of turn, in a safe and responsible way, to help pace of play.

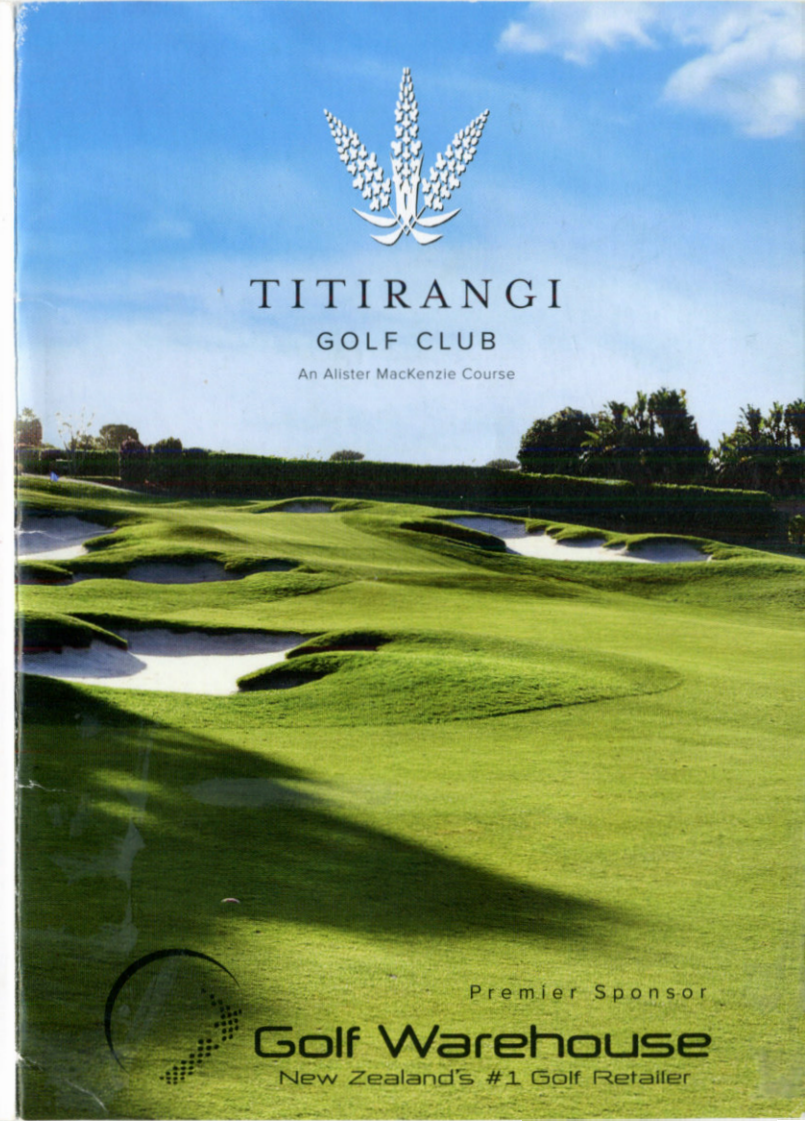

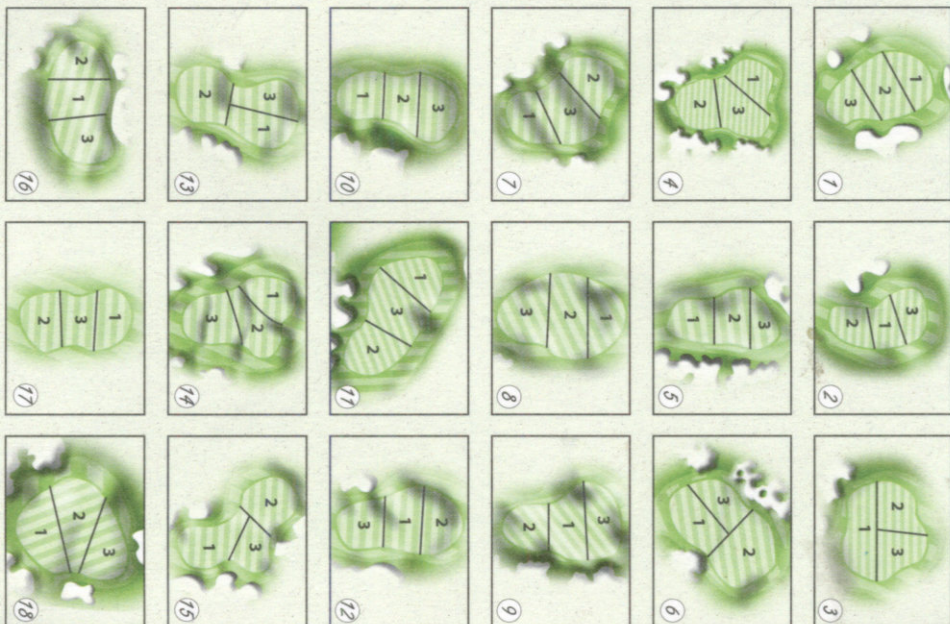

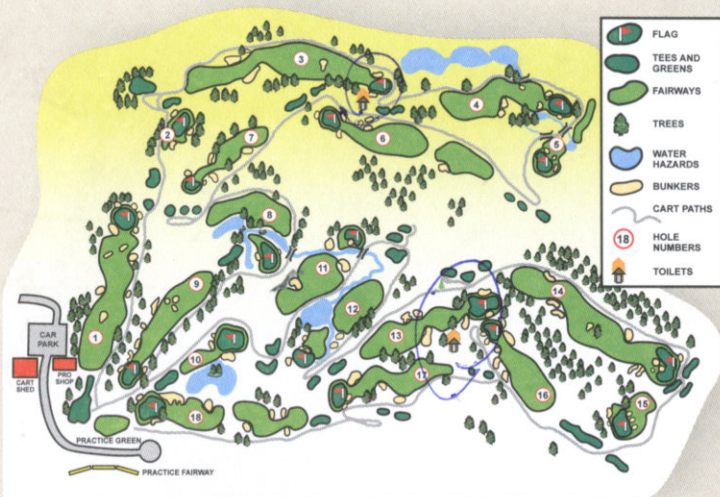

LOCAL RULES

(To be read in conjunction with Rules of Golf) (Penalty for breach of local rule - Stroke Play - 2 strokes. Match Play - Loss of hole.)

- 1/ **SPRINKLER HEADS.** A ball may not be played within 40cm of these cover plates - lift and drop without penalty.
- 2/ **LATERAL WATER HAZARDS. A/** Holes 4, 5, 8, 10, 11, 12 & 18. All stones & rocks in and on the edge of all water hazards are an integral part of the hazard. **B/** Hole 6 is marked with red stakes.
- 3/ **G.U.R. - WHITE STAKES/NOTICES.**
- 4/ **PATHWAYS.** A ball lying on any formed pathway, or roadway, may be lifted and dropped, within 1 club length of the nearest point of relief not nearer the hole, without penalty.
- 5/ **CART PATHS, STAKES, LOGS, PEGS, ROPES & SIGNS** are deemed to be immovable objects. Don't remove any ropes or signs.
- 6/ **ALL** boundary fences and Green Keepers Areas are **OUT OF BOUNDS.**
- 7/ **POUNCE WALLS** are an integral part of the bunker (Superseded by Rule 12)

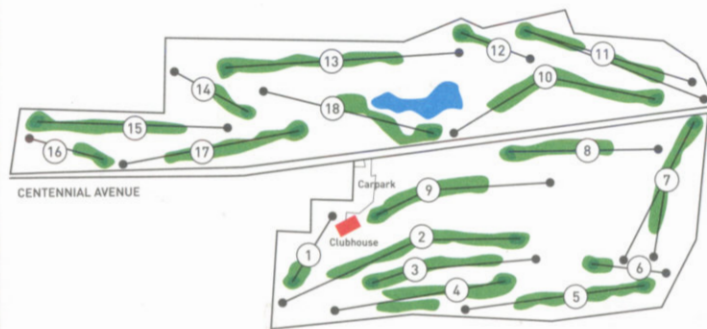
Free Relief

6. When sprinkler head or drain cover is on the player's line of play, within two club lengths of the putting green and is within two club lengths of the ball (Rule 16.1b).

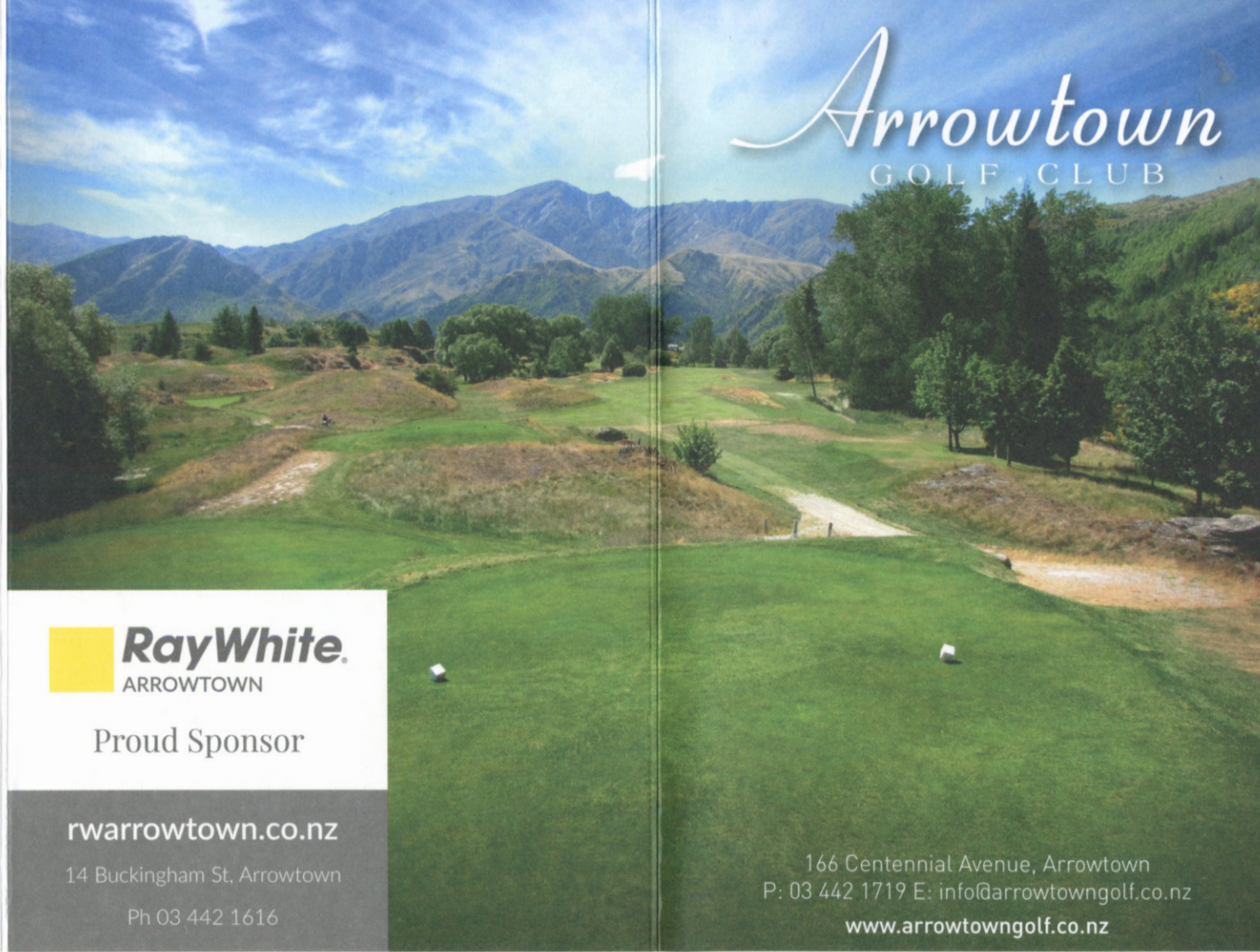

All parts of the course watering system, all formed paths, roadways and stacked stone walls are deemed to be immovable obstructions. Rule 24-2B applies. Relief is one club length.
- 4) **Course directional signage**
Optional re-play without penalty if your ball strikes any course signage/directional markers.

Yellow 90m, **White** 135m, **Blue** 150, **Black** 180m.

- 4) Course toilet - located at the 10th Hole beside the Black/Blue Tee.
- 5) Matchplay games are to be played off the match hole ratings - all other games use stroke hole ratings.
