Tuesday, 4th April

When you arrive into Augusta you will be met by Robert Whan from ATFS at the baggage arrival area. Luxury Self-Drive transportation is reserved during entire program. Wednesday, 5th April

Today will all play the Reynolds Plantation National Course. This member's exclusive course has manicured greens and great golf. After golf is available for sightseeing, souvenir shopping or watching The Masters third day on television from 3.30pm until 6.30pm. Dinner tonight is unhosted.

Sunday, 9th April

Spend the entire day at The Masters "Green Jacket Day". Gates open at 8.00am. First Tee Time approximately 10.00am. Hosted farewell dinner and drinks at Cadwalladers Restaurant (the best).
